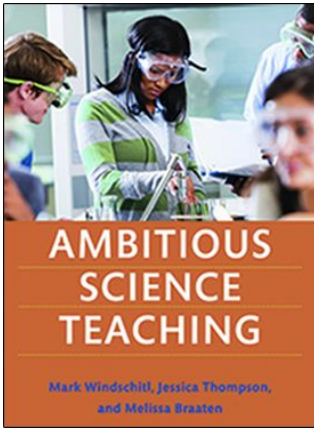


# Calling All Elementary Teachers !!!
